Sports analytics is the application of AI, data science, psychology, and smart devices to improve sports performance, strategy, and decision-making. It involves collecting, processing, and interpreting data from various sources such as video footage, performance metrics, and scouting reports, and using this information to gain insights into player and team performance, prevent injury, and help coaches and team managers to make more informed decisions and optimize their resources to achieve better results.

The vision of this International Sports Analytics Conference and Exhibition (ISACE) series is to bring leading academics, researchers, coaches, psychologists, managers and technologists together to advance state-of-the-art of sports analytics. The location will move around the world's major cities with a timing that is likely to be 1-2 weeks before or after a major sporting event which may form one of the themes of the conference. The first ISACE (12-13 July 2024) will be in Paris (one week before Summer Olympics).

Conference proceedings will be **published in Springer LNCS series**. **Best papers** will be awarded a certificate and a book voucher by Springer-Nature. Selected papers will be invited to submit an extended version to a **special issue of the Spring-Nature Computer Science journal**.
