The vision of this International Sports Analytics Conference and Exhibition (ISACE) series is to bring leading academics, researchers, coaches, psychologists, managers, and technologists together to advance the state-of-the-art of sports analytics. The location will move around the world's major cities with a timing that is likely to be 1-2 weeks before or after a major sporting event which may form one of the themes of the conference. The upcoming ISACE (**26-27 September 2025**) will be in **Shanghai (a few days before the 2025 Rolex Shanghai Masters tennis tournament)**. The conference banquet will be held at the Oriental Pearl TV Tower in Shanghai. A sightseeing tour is also included in the registration package.

Conference proceedings will be **published in the Springer LNCS series**. **Best papers** will be awarded a certificate and a book voucher by Springer-Nature. Selected papers will be invited to submit an extended version to a **special issue of the Spring-Nature Computer Science journal**.
